
Take Care of Your Gutters and Downspouts Before Fall

Here's how to take care of your gutters and downspouts before fall arrives.

Climb the Ladder?


If you're so inclined, use a sturdy, tall ladder, gloves, and safety goggles to go to work on your roof. It goes without saying that this is risky, and one false move can result in serious injury or even death. It's best to call a professional who specializes in this. Although we don't clean the gutters, we can rod or flush out lines depending on how they are set up.

Clean and Flush the Gutters

If you must go up there on your own, bring a garden trowel or homemade scoop with you to collect the debris from the gutter trough. Use a gardening hose to flush out the gutter to ensure removal of micro debris and proper flow. If the water isn't draining, it's time to address the downspout strainer. Again, we highly recommend dispatching your plumber for your safety and to save a lot of time.

Check Your Downspouts

A downspout--also known as a waterspout, downpipe, drain spout, roof drain pipe, and leader--is a pipe that carries rainwater from a gutter. If your downspout isn't draining, there's likely a clog that can lead to flooding.



Make sure you check all of your downspout drains around the exterior of your home, and if they're not draining, call your plumber to snake out the blockage.
